# School Sports Grant

## Planned expenditure: SSG 2018/19

### Introduction:

At Minchinhampton we have received funding, as part of the Olympic Legacy to schools in England, to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sports provision in our school. The money can be spent in any way that enhances the teaching of PE and leads to a healthy and active lifestyle. One of the conditions of this money is that we must publish on our website how we have spent the money so far and what plans we have to spend the rest. To ensure we make the most of this funding and gain maximum impact from it, we have conducted thorough audits of PE and Sports provision in our school, working with an external specialist. We have formulated an action plan based on the findings.

### Aims:

For sporting excellence to be established and maintained at Minchinhampton, we are pursuing two key aims in the medium term: firstly to develop a strong working relationship with a sports provider with links to the local community and secondly to improve the school's sports infrastructure. The key outcomes we desire are:-

**A**-for <u>all</u> pupils to have a positive attitude towards physical activity and sport and to recognise its many benefits, including health;

**B**-for all pupils to take opportunities to nurture their mental health and wellbeing within the school day.

**C**-for <u>all</u> pupils to have pursued or be currently pursuing an interest in at least one sport and to want to continue with some form of sport when they leave Minchinhampton;

#### Aims in spending PPG this year 2018/19

\*To develop our provision for sports—

To deepen our partnership with dedicated coach employed now for 5 days as a member of staff. The aim is to continue building the profile of sport generally in school.

We will be building a programme of cooperative sports with strong links being made back to pupil learning attitudes across the curriculum.

\*<u>To improve mental health outcomes</u> for pupils across the school, including:--coach supporting pupils who are presently struggling emotionally/ with social skills/ with fitness.

-coach to support all pupils to improve their cooperative skills

-to build on our provision for yoga and mindfulness

#### **Objectives in spending PPG this year 2018/19**

We want to raise the profile of sport generally in school and develop positive attitudes for all pupils; continue to increase participation in sport for all pupils year on year so we will:-

- Coach in for 5 days a week.
- Continue to build on our sports resources.
- Build a centre for mindfulness and yoga
- Continue to build links with local community sports.
