SCHOOL COMMS: We are now using Schoolcomms as a way of paying for trips online. When a trip is set up on the system you will receive a text alert to let you know you can pay via schoolcomms. You can download the app, which is called **School Gateway**, within your app store. We would encourage parents to do this as all correspondence will then be seen in your app, rather than an individual text or email notification. This is also a very cost effective way for the school to contact you. The app is free to download and also works with Secondary Schools who use School Comms. Please see the 'Welcome to Schoolcomms' letter **here**. If you cannot access the app, please let us know and we can look into this for you.
