The subject of this week's INSET training was restorative practice, with a focus on building, maintaining and restoring relationships and giving people agency in their own lives. There were many things that came out of the day that are already formative in our school culture; how we get along with each other, our differences as an asset, the importance of curiosity rather than judgement and collaboration rather than competition, being responsible for what's yours and allowing others to be responsible for what's theirs, listening to understand, asking more than telling and, through a belief in people and relationships, kindness. With its roots in the practices of indigenous peoples, we have much to learn from and be inspired by this creative, fair and humanistic approach.

Inset day: On Monday the 13th of January the teachers came and had a discussion about restorative practice. This is all about a way of working with children when they were struggling with their feelings before and being there to understand everybody, perceive their feelings and listening to each other without judgement. This is also a very cost effective way for the school to contact you. The app is free to download and also works with Secondary Schools who use School Comms.
