Up to 8 pupils will be able to stay in each chalet or tent and there will of course be a member of Minchinhampton staff sleeping outside in a tent. # **Sweets**

We will take some sweets with us as fun prizes and/or treats for everyone. We do not want children to bring their own sweets please. If they do bring them, we will keep them safe until we arrive back. Please can you encourage them to respect this rule and assure them we will have plenty of treats with us.

#### Kit List

This will be sent out on Thursday and available at the meeting. In addition to the items on the list, children will also need night clothes and clothes to wear in the evening. These can be scruffy clothes as mentioned on the list or maybe jeans if children prefer. If the weather is particularly wet, it would be useful for the children to have wellies to wear for the night walk. Torches are essential for pupils staying in the chalets and would be useful, but not essential, for those staying in the house. The journey to Viney Hill is relatively short so please IPods and other electronic games, including phones, must be left at home. Pupils may bring cameras, which must be clearly labelled. It would also be advisable for children to bring plastic bin bags (at least 2) to store any damp or dirty clothes.

#### Contact whist we are away

#### **Departure**

Please could your child be at school, with their luggage, at 8:45am on Monday 27<sup>th</sup> March. All suitcases need to be lined up on the bottom playground if it is dry and in the hall if it is wet. Please give all medicines to the member of staff sitting at the 'medicines table.' Children will need to keep their day bags, <u>including their lunch</u>, pocket money (see below), waterproof coat and water bottle with them.

We will arrive back at school at 2:45pm on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> March. We ask that parents, unless helping to unload the coach, remain on the playground until all luggage and pupils are off the coach. Pupils will remain on the coach until all luggage has been taken off.
